Skyline Homicide Victim Identified

San Diego – A man was arrested for murder and attempted murder after shooting a man inside his home, then walking to a nearby liquor store and shooting in the direction of an employee behind the counter.

On April 27, 2025, at about 8:24 a.m., San Diego Police Communications received a report of a gunshot and man walking with a gun around 7900 Skyline Drive. As officers arrived on scene, they received an update of a reported robbery at the nearby Moonlight Liquor, located at 101 South Meadowbrook Drive. This caller indicated someone had fired a gun inside the business.

As they checked the area, police observed a man matching the suspect description walk into the backyard of 8240 Skyline Drive. They observed blood on the man and blood near the front door of the residence. Officers set a perimeter around the property and called for the assistance of the SWAT team. While waiting for additional resources to arrive, officers observed the suspect take off his clothes in the backyard and saw him manipulating a handgun. Eventually, the man put the gun down, got dressed, and surrendered to officers.

Because of the blood near the front door, officers conducted a welfare check inside the residence. They located a man in his fifties suffering from at least one gunshot wound. The man was transported to a nearby hospital, but, unfortunately, he did not survive his injuries. He is now identified as 56-year-old Luis Adrian Godinez Gonzalez. The suspect is identified as 35-year-old Adrian Godinez. The victim is the suspect's father and both men lived in the residence.

Investigators have learned that shots inside the house likely occurred around 8:00 a.m., shortly before the liquor store shooting. Although the shooting was initially reported as a robbery, the suspect is not believed to have taken anything from the store. Godinez was booked into County Jail for one count of murder and one count of attempted murder.
