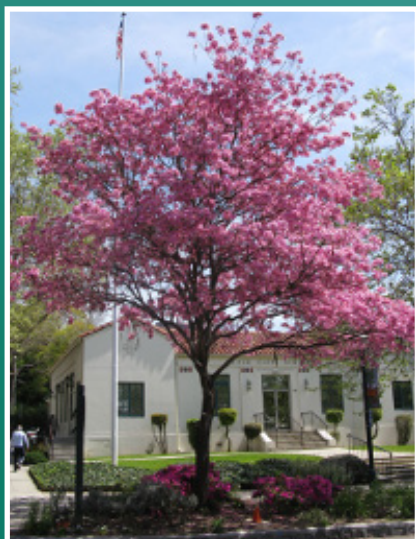
ABOUT THE PROJECT
