SUBJECT: Smart Streetlight Camera Locations

After a final round of gathering feedback and reviewing potential sites, the Department has chosen locations for its remaining Smart Streetlights.

As this board knows, the Department ran into several issues while installing the 500 cameras that were first approved in August 2023. These challenges left the department with about 60 unplaced cameras. In February we shared where most of those cameras would be located. The below sites are our final selections.

The Department considered crime data, investigator feedback, pedestrian and traffic safety concerns, the locations of main thoroughfares, and input from residents and city leaders when settling on the below locations:

- Deep Dell Road and Paradise Valley Road, northwest corner
- Deep Dell Road and Paradise Valley Road, northeast corner
- Deep Dell Road and Paradise Valley Road, southwest corner
- Deep Dell Road and Paradise Valley Road, southeast corner
- Euclid Avenue and Imperial Avenue, northwest corner
- Euclid Avenue and Imperial Avenue, northeast corner
- Euclid Avenue and Imperial Avenue, southwest corner
- Euclid Avenue and Imperial Avenue, southeast corner
- Alta View Drive and South Woodman Street, southwest corner
- Alta View Drive and South Woodman Street, northeast corner
- Imperial Avenue and 68th Street, southeast corner

Additionally, the Department will be relocating the following cameras due to infrastructure deficiencies at previously proposed locations:

- From 4001 First Avenue to the southwest corner of Bernardo Center and Cloudcrest Drive
- From 9500 Mira Mesa Boulevard to the southeast corner of Rancho Bernardo Road and West Bernardo Drive
- From 11500 Rancho Bernardo Road to the northwest corner of Rancho Bernardo Road and West Bernardo Drive

Smart Streetlights Locations

- From 5400 University Avenue to the northeast corner of Sandrock Road and Hammond Drive
- From 4600 Border Village Drive to the northeast corner of Otay Mesa Road and Ocean View Hills Parkway

We will inform the board should any of our cameras need to be moved in the future. We appreciate the input we received from both city officials and community members throughout this process and look forward to continuing our work together to make this program a success.
