# NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

### **SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT**

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - San Diego Pride Festival 2025

**COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Balboa Park

**COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3** 

LOCATION: Western portion of Balboa Park, Marston Point, Balboa Drive from Laurel Street and Sixth

Avenue (see attached map)

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Special Event Permit for a 2-day festival that would include vendors, gaming zone, sports activities, car display, art exhibits, children's activities, cultural presentations, entertainment, music, alcohol, food vendors, food trucks, onsite food preparation, fenced-in beer gardens, dance floors, stages, tents/canopies, generators, fencing and/or barriers, tables, chairs, lounge furniture, portable restrooms, and trash/recycling containers. The event would occur on July 19 & 20, 2025. Alcohol would be served from 11 AM until 10 PM on July 19<sup>th</sup>, and from 11 AM until 9 PM on July 20<sup>th</sup>. Noise associated with the event activities and setup/dismantling would occur from 8 AM on July 15, 2025, until 5 PM on July 22, 2025. Set-up would occur from 8 AM until 8 PM on July 15<sup>th</sup>, and from 6 AM until 10 PM on July 17<sup>th</sup>, and July 18<sup>th</sup>, and from 5 AM until 11 AM on July 19<sup>th</sup>. The event would occur from 11 AM until 10:30 PM on July 19<sup>th</sup>, and from 11 AM until 9:30 PM on July 20<sup>th</sup>. Dismantling would occur from 6 AM until 10 PM on July 21<sup>st</sup> and from 6 AM until 5 PM on July 22, 2025.

#### Parking lot and road closures would be associated with this event.

On July 16, 2025, at 6 AM until July 21, 2025, at 8 PM:

- Balboa Drive south of Laurel Street,
- 6<sup>th</sup> Ave between Laurel St and Juniper
- Laurel Street between 6<sup>th</sup> Ave and Balboa Dr.

On July 19, 2025, at 5 AM until July 21, 2025, at 6 AM:

- Both sides of Juniper between 5<sup>th</sup> Av and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue;

On July 16, 2025, at 6 AM until 8 PM on July 21, 2025.

- Both side of Juniper between 6<sup>th</sup> and Balboa Dr.
- Balboa Dr. between Quince to Laurel St. from July 19, 2025, at 5 AM until 11 PM on July 20, 2025.

# The following additional parking would also be closed:

- East side of 6th Avenue between lvy and Laurel (lvy no parking needed per PD)
- On July 16, 2025, at 6 AM until 5 PM on July 22, 2025:
  - The Marston Point Parking Lot

On July 16, 2025, at 6 AM until 8 PM on July 21, 2025.

- Both side of Juniper between 6<sup>th</sup> and Balboa Dr.

On July 19, 2025, at 5 AM until 11 PM on July 20, 2025.

- Balboa Dr. between Quince to Laurel St.

**STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
