### ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve the appointment of Commissioner Alessandra Moctezuma as Vice Chair for the City of San Diego Commission for Arts and Culture.

### Background:

In accordance with San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) §26.0701 et seq., the Vice Chair shall be nominated by the Chair and elected by a majority vote of the Commission for Arts and Culture.

The Vice Chair serves in the absence or incapacity of the Chair and assumes the Chair's responsibilities if the position is vacated before the end of the term. The Vice Chair also provides general support to the Chair and the Commission for Arts and Culture's Executive Committee.

### Relevant Regulations:

As outlined in SDMC §26.0701 et seq. and Commission's Rules and Regulations:

- One member of the Commission may be designated by the Mayor as Chair in September of each year in which a Chair is to be selected, or in absence of such designation by the Commission for Arts and Culture on or after October 15.
- The Chair nominates a Vice Chair.
- The Vice Chair is elected by a majority vote of the Commission for Arts and Culture.
- The Vice Chair assumes the duties of the Chair if the Chair is absent, incapacitated, or the position becomes vacant.
