Statement: ADU Reforms Win Council Approval, Safeguards Neighborhood Safety While Supporting Housing Needs

SAN DIEGO — Following today's vote at the San Diego City Council to reform the city's Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) program, City Councilmember Raul Campillo (D7) released the following statement:

"Today's ADU reforms reflect common sense and real progress — balancing real concerns about safety, infrastructure, and community character with the urgent need for housing," said Councilmember Raul Campillo. "These changes ensure the ADU program stays true to its intended purpose: providing more homes, not full-blown apartment complexes in people's backyards. No longer will our ADU program be a backdoor for large-scale projects that don't resemble anyone's idea of a granny flat."
