**SUBJECT:** FY2025 REQUIRED RADAR AND LIDAR CALIBRATIONS

**SCOPE:** ALL MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT

## **DEPARTMENT PROCEDURE AFFECTED:**

Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be records of security procedures and are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act (CPRA), Government Code Section 7923.600 or are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be exempt from public disclosure because the public interest served by not disclosing the information clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure, pursuant to California Government Code section 7922.000.

All department RADAR and LIDAR units must be calibrated per California Vehicle Code requirements. Calibrations will be performed by an independent contractor at the (**Deleted** – **records of security**) on the following dates and times:

Officers with individually assigned RADAR/LIDAR units must be present during the calibration. For units installed in patrol vehicles, the respective patrol command must designate an officer to transport the vehicle to the (**Deleted – records of security**).

The calibration process takes approximately 15 minutes per unit. No appointment is necessary; service will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Calibrations are on-duty only; overtime is not authorized.

If an officer is unable to attend during the scheduled times, they must arrange for another officer to deliver their unit to the (**Deleted – records of security**). Alternatively, units may be dropped off at the (**Deleted – records of security**)

Failure to calibrate your unit during this period may result in additional departmental costs and the device's possible reassignment.
