Fourth of July weekend is one of the busiest holiday weekends of the summer. To provide the maximum level of staffing for our beaches and neighborhoods, the Department will be moving to a mandatory **(Deleted – records of security)** off schedule starting Friday, July **(Deleted – records of security)** and ending Monday, July **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.

The mandatory **(Deleted – records of security)** shifts will include all Patrol Operations, Traffic Motors, and CIB, as well as the Neighborhood Policing Division. Shift hours will be as follows:

- Officers working first watch will work **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.
- Officers working second watch will work **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.
- Officers working third watch will work **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.

All second watch personnel will be assigned to Beach Command at Northern or Western Division. More information will be forthcoming on specific beach operations assignments, assigned supervisors, and the equipment officers will be required to bring.

All personnel on days off are encouraged to work one of the approved overtime assignments that are available.
