The City Planning Department is asking planning groups to submit priorities for infrastructure projects and improvements for the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP). The Board will discuss and make recommendations on which projects should be prioritized.

3. Discussion and Potential Action on California SB 79

Senate Bill 79 allows more housing development near major public transportation stops by upzoning land within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile of specified major transit stops. Specifically, SB 79 allows multifamily housing up to a specified height, density, and floor area ratio on residential, mixed use, and commercial land near rail and bus rapid transit. The bill also provides transit agencies with the land use authority to develop residential and commercial projects on certain land they control. Transit-oriented development projects under SB 79 are eligible for the streamlined ministerial approvals process without community participation. The Board will discuss this bill and consider taking a position

Per a recent court filing, the San Diego City Council is considering terminating the open space easement and ending all restrictions on the City-owned open space currently occupied by the Surf Cup Sports and Fairbanks Ranch Country Club leases. The Board will discuss this recent development and consider taking appropriate action.
