## Reduced Cost for Swim Lessons at the Vista Terrace Pool



### SWIMMING LESSONS



#### BEFORE SWIMMING LESSON REGISTRATION:

All pools have requirements for swim lesson registration. **Prior to registering**, all returning participants will need to confirm with pool staff to ensure the correct prerequisite skills are listed on their [SDRecConnect](#) account. Otherwise ActiveNet will not allow you to register for any upper level lessons.

If this is the first time registering for lessons with the City of San Diego, contact pool staff to schedule a participant assessment and help create an [SDRecConnect](#) account.

Participants must be evaluated by staff prior to registration.

#### REGISTRATION

Online and Walk-in registration opens at 12:00pm on the registration dates listed by session dates.

Pool staff is available to assist with all on-line and walk-in registration concerns.

#### FREE NEW CLASS! Water Competency

Participants may register for one session at a time. Enrollment in multiple sessions will result in removal from all but the first registered class. Once a session is completed, participants become eligible to register for another. Please consult pool staff for class availability and registration dates.

This class focuses on foundational water safety and swimming skills. Goggles are not permitted at this level.

Participants will work toward mastering the **Water Competency Sequence**, which must be completed in the following order, without pauses, assistance, or touching the wall:

1. Jump into deep water (overhead depth), surface, and recover.
2. Float on the back or tread water for 1 minute.
3. Rotate 360° and orient toward the designated exit.
4. Swim 25 yards using front crawl with rhythmic breathing or elementary backstroke. Exit the pool without using a ladder, gutter, or assistance.

## Next Steps For Customers Eligible For City-Provided Trash Services

Changes are coming to San Diego's trash and recycling collection service, following the adoption of a new cost-recovery fee that will ensure the modernization and sustainability of the City's waste collection program.

### Next steps:

**July 1:** The new Solid Waste Management Fee becomes effective for approximately 226,500 customers receiving waste and recycling collection services from the City. Existing fees for container repairs, replacements or delivery are repealed. Between July 1 and Aug. 10, the City will provide a list of its customers to San Diego County, as the fee will be collected via the San Diego County tax roll.

**July 15:** A new web-based Residential Waste Collection Services Portal will allow customers to log in and select the size(s) and number(s) of containers for their property. Mailers are currently being sent to residents with instructions on how to use the Portal. Customers are asked to make their selections by Sept. 30.

**October 2025 to June 2026:** The City will deliver new containers and remove old containers. Customers should first see the charge on their tax bills by October 2025.

## City of San Diego Eviction Prevention Program

The City of San Diego Eviction Prevention Program (EPP) helps renters with low income in the City of San Diego who are facing eviction for not paying their rent. EPP is operated by *Legal Aid Society of San Diego* through a contract with the *San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC)*.

### Eligibility

- Reside at a City of San Diego address;
- Have household income at or below 80% of San Diego's Area Median Income (\$121,250/year for a family of four); and
- Have an obligation to pay rent.

## Housing Instability Prevention Program

The *Housing Instability Prevention Program (HIPP)* helps pay rent and other housing-related expenses for families in the City of San Diego with low income, experiencing a housing crisis and at risk of homelessness. The *San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC)* operates HIPP for the City of San Diego with funding the *San Diego City Council* allocated specifically for the creation and continuation of this program.

### How It Works

- SDHC provides enrolled households with \$250, \$500, \$750 or \$1,000 per month toward their rent, depending on the household's circumstances.
- HIPP also provides case management and assists with housing-related expenses, such as past-due rent and past-due utilities, depending on the household's need. These payments are made directly to the landlord or utility company.
- Enrolled households receive assistance for up to 24 months.

### Who is Eligible?

- Must be a leaseholder and living in the City of San Diego
- Spending more than 40 percent of their gross income on housing in San Diego.
- After the rent subsidy is applied, the household cannot spend more than 80 percent of its income on rent.
- Experiencing a housing crisis, such as facing eviction, and at risk of homelessness.
- No alternative housing options. • Lack the money and support network to resolve their housing crisis.
- Household income is at or below 80 percent of San Diego's Area Median Income, currently \$121,250 per year for a family of four

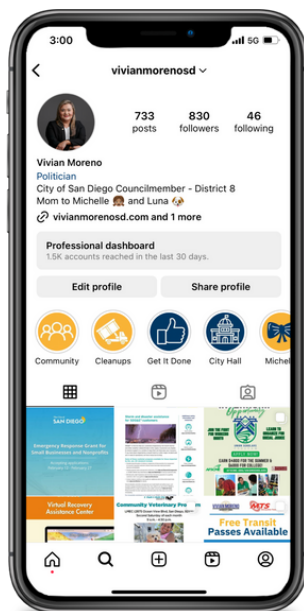
