Action Item: Approve/Disapprove a letter from the KTPG to the City of San Diego supporting the boundaries of the Talmadge Park Estates National Historic District. While the State Historical Resources Commission and the City of San Diego's Historic Resources Board supported the boundaries of the national district, the Los Angeles based consultants, hired by the City for the Mid-City Community Plan update, did not.
