

Next Phase of Traffic Control on Clairemont Drive

June 27, 2025

Crews have made progress installing the pipeline on Clairemont Drive between Lakehurst Avenue and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard. We appreciate the patience and cooperation of the surrounding residents and businesses throughout this important phase of work.

Crews have begun installing the next phase of traffic control on Clairemont Drive to allow for pipeline installation. Beginning Monday, June 30, crews will begin installing the pipeline at the intersection of Clairemont Drive and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard.

Access to Cole Street via Clairemont Drive will be restricted. To access Cole Street, drivers will be detoured to Clairemont Mesa Boulevard and Conrad Avenue. One northbound and one southbound lane of traffic will be maintained through the work zone.

Pipeline installation will take place between 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. This phase of work is anticipated to last approximately 6 weeks.
