

The City of San Diego is rehabilitating and replacing 4.7 miles of trunk sewer pipe and installing a water main. These repairs and upgrades will:

- Help prevent line ruptures and improve service
- Provide additional capacity for the sewer system

What to Expect at Tecolote Canyon Golf Course: While construction is occurring on the course, golfers can expect to see heavy equipment, open trenches, safety fencing and typical underground construction operations. Noise and dust will be mitigated.

The golf course will make any hole closures known when booking tee times. Closures will only occur when necessary to ensure safety during construction. The City of San Diego project team is working closely with the Tecolote Canyon Golf Course and American Golf to keep as much of the course open as possible during the project. Work within the Tecolote Canyon Golf Course is expected to last from August 2025 to Spring 2026, during Phase 2 of the project.

Golf Course Construction Phase 1 of 3

Work in the golf course starts at **Hole 11** with open-cut trench sewer main installation.

The red line signifies the alignment of the new sewer main.



Work within the Tecolote Canyon Golf Course is expected to last from August 2025 to Spring 2026.

The golf course will make any hole closures known when booking tee times.

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Golf Course Construction Phase 2 of 3

Work continues to the first trenchless pipe installation section at Hole 14.

The green cloud signifies the alignment being tunneled.



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Golf Course Construction Phase 3 of 3

The golf course work finishes at the start of the course, with both open-cut trench and trenchless pipe installation segments.

The water main work will be between **Hole 18** and **Hole 1**.



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
