

Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Reminder: Nighttime Pipeline Work Will Begin on Sunday, August 24

Crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project will start nighttime pipeline installation work on Sunday night, August 24. This portion of work will start on Friars Road, in the westbound lanes, just east of Mission Center Road. As they make progress installing pipeline, crews will move east on Friars Road toward I-805.

Crews will be working Sunday night through Friday morning, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. For example, their first shift of the week will will begin at 8 p.m. Sunday, and conclude at 6 a.m. Monday. Their last shift of the week will begin at 8 p.m. Thursday, and conclude at 6 a.m. Friday morning.

During working hours, typical noise and dust are expected. All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone, and follow all posted signage.

In addition to installing new pipelines, crews will also be replacing select curb ramps along the project alignment to bring them up to current ADA standards. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will install temporary paving to cover the trench and continue to install pipeline. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
