One Arrested in Gaslamp Bar Homicide

San Diego – A man was shot and killed inside a Gaslamp Area bar Sunday evening. The suspected shooter was quickly detained by others inside the bar and handed over to police.

On August 3, 2025, at approximately 5:18 p.m., multiple people called San Diego Police and reported a shooting on the third floor of a bar located at 701 Sixth Avenue. Officers arrived and quickly located a man on the sidewalk in front of the business being detained by several people. The group identified the man as the shooter and directed officers to a handgun they had reportedly recovered from him.

Officers made their way into the business and located a man on the ground in a third-floor hallway area suffering from at least one gunshot wound. Officers and paramedics rendered first aid at the scene, but the man did not survive his injuries. He is described as a 46-year-old Black male.

The suspect, 37-year-old Bryan Tyner, was arrested for the shooting and will be booked into County Jail on one count of murder. He is described as a Black male from San Diego.
