One Dead in Miramar Shooting

San Diego – A man was shot and killed while sitting in a vehicle in the Miramar neighborhood.

On September 3, at 4:01 p.m., San Diego Police received several calls of a male who had been shot while seated in the front passenger seat of a vehicle parked on the 8600 block of Production Avenue. Officers located the victim and immediately began life-saving measures until San Diego Fire-Rescue paramedics arrived. The victim was transported to the hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

Immediately after the shooting, the suspect ran northbound from the scene. Witnesses described him as a white male adult in his 40's, wearing a black shirt and dark colored shorts. San Diego Police personnel searched the area and a nearby RV that was parked and possibly associated with the suspect. He was not located and is not in custody.

San Diego Police Homicide investigators were called to the scene and are currently investigating this incident. It is still early in the investigation and detectives are in the process of determining what events prompted the fatal shooting of the victim.

The deceased male has been identified but his name is being withheld pending family notifications. He is described as a 57-year-old Hispanic male.
