NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - CAF Community Challenge Weekend

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: La Jolla

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 2

LOCATION: Ellen Browning Scripps Park - 1100 Coast Blvd La Jolla, CA 92037

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a triathlon event that would take place at Ellen Browning Scripps Park and surrounding roadways on October 26, 2025. The event would include the swim, bike, and run routes as shown on the attached maps, clinics, a stage, generators, music, entertainment, sound amplification, canopies, tables, chairs, vehicle mounted grandstands, onsite food preparation, food trucks, a drone, portable restrooms, and trash/recycling containers. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 8 AM on October 24, 2025, to 10 PM on October 26, 2025. Set-up would occur from 8 AM until 10 PM on October 24, 2025, and from 7 AM until 10 PM on October 25, 2025. On October 26, 2025, the event would occur from 4 AM until 10 PM, and dismantling would occur from 3 PM until 10 PM.

Road closures associated with the event would occur on October 26, 2025, and would consists of the following locations:

- Coast Blvd. between Prospect Pl. and Coast Blvd. where it turns into Girard Ave from 2 AM to 10 PM
- Number 1 Lane Closure Heading Northbound on Torrey Pines Rd from Prospect to La Jolla Shores Drive from 7 AM to 10 PM

Associated street parking would be closed and would consists of the following locations:

- all parking spaces on Coast Blvd between Ocean Street and Cave Street on October 26, 2025, from 12 AM to 9 PM
- (10) parking spots in front of Scripps Park to include ADA parking spots from 8 AM on October 24, 2025, until 10 PM on October 25, 2025

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311 (Accessory Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal.

Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building— Public Information Counter (Open 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday excluding City approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101,

by 5:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.

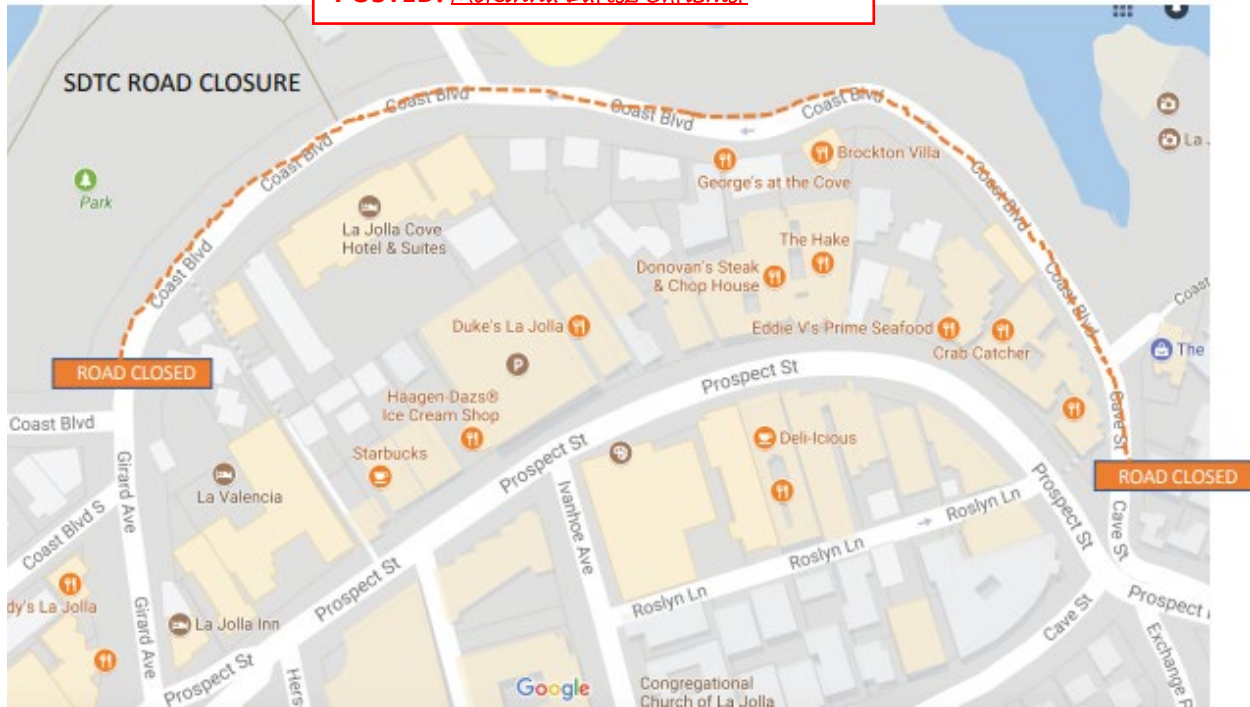

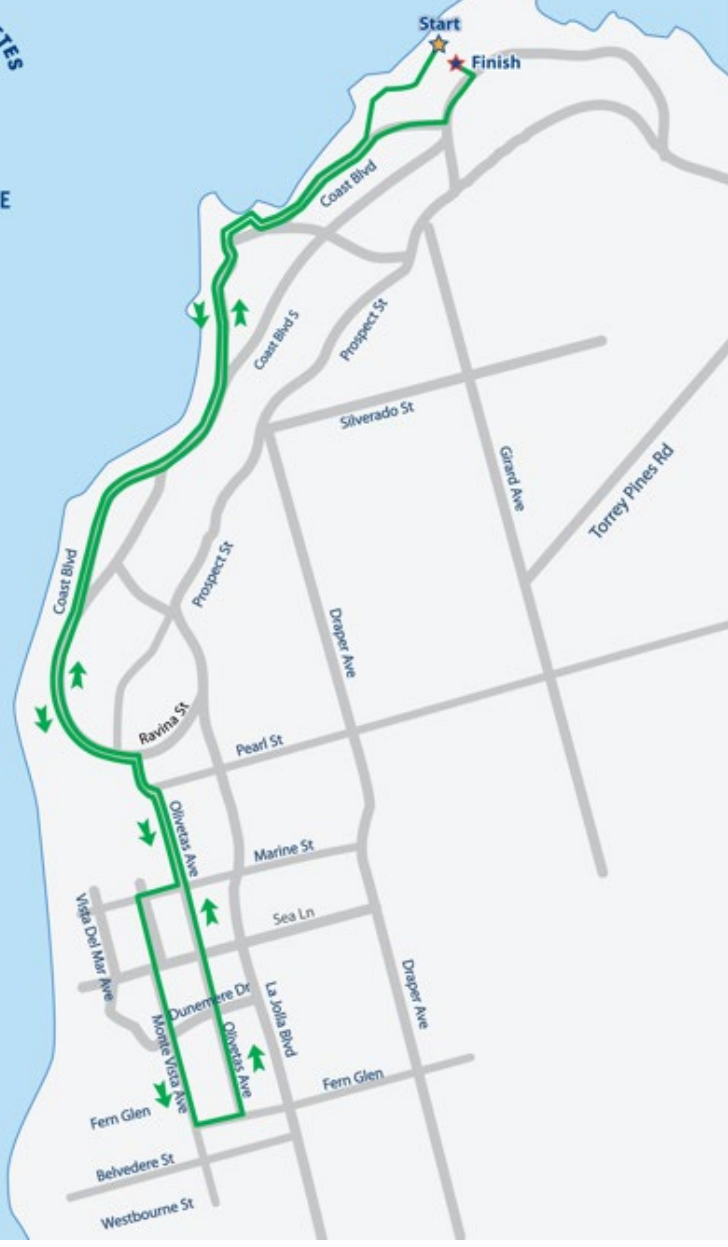

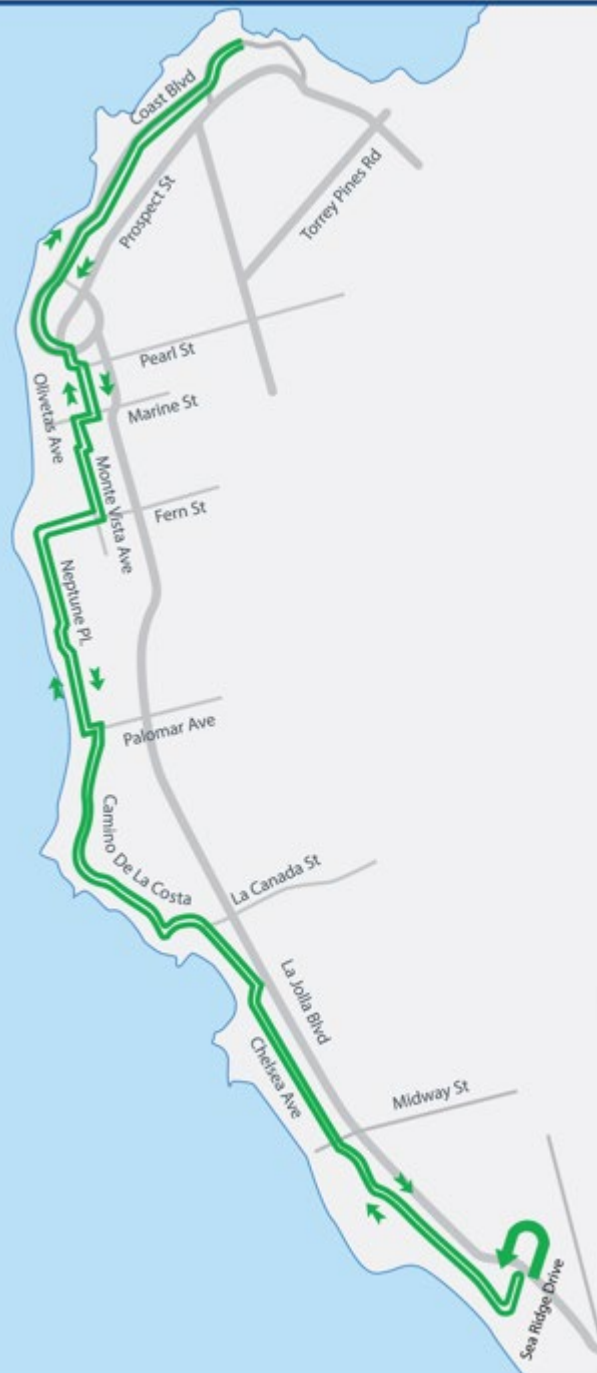
BIKE COURSE ELEVATION
