

Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

No Work Sunday Night 8/31 or Monday Night 9/1

Crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project will not be working on Sunday night, 8/31 or Monday night, 9/1 for the Labor Day holiday. Night work is scheduled to resume on Tuesday night, 9/2. Crews will continue to install pipeline on Friars Road, in the westbound lanes, just east of Mission Center Road. As they make progress installing pipeline, crews will move east on Friars Road toward I-805.

During working hours, typical noise and dust are expected. All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone, and follow all posted signage.

In addition to installing new pipelines, crews will also be replacing select curb ramps along the project alignment to bring them up to current ADA standards. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will install temporary paving to cover the trench and continue to install pipeline. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
