Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Crews Will Work Daytime Hours Moving Forward

Crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project switched to daytime work hours starting Tuesday, September 2. The working hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Traffic control and the barriers around the work zone will remain in place around the clock, so after a shift is finished there will still be traffic control elements staying in the roadway.

There may be occasions in the future where portions of night work are required, and advanced notification via email will be provided before any night work occurs.

Crews are continue to install pipeline on their current path on Friars Road, in the westbound lanes, just east of Mission Center Road. As they make progress installing pipeline, they are moving east on Friars Road toward I-805.

During working hours, typical noise and dust are expected. All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone, and follow all posted signage.

In addition to installing new pipelines, crews will also be replacing select curb ramps along the project alignment to bring them up to current ADA standards. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will install temporary paving to cover the trench and continue to install pipeline. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
