301. Discussion – Ability to designate/allocate/save funds for future park improvement projects

Typically, the City hesitates allocating funds for projects that are uncertain and not yet identified due to "risk aversion". Therefore, the City tends to fund lower "priority" certain projects that have been identified, due to the risk of wasting money. Judith recommended a future MBPIFOC agenda item to request legality of earmarking Improvement Funds for future environmental projects

Savannah Stallings appreciated Judith's effects to fund "priority" projects. She suggested sending a letter to the City sating they are in violation of the City Charter regarding Improvement Fund allocations. She encourages priority project funding
