CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Night Work at Clairemont Dr. and Denver St.

Crews are currently installing pipelines near the intersection of Clairemont Drive and Denver Street as part of the Morena Conveyance South and Middle and Morena Conveyance Pipelines project. To maintain the safety of the community during this construction, crews are expected to continue performing overnight work in stages on Denver Street and Clairemont Drive from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m., Sunday through Friday, for approximately 3-4 weeks.

Work involves crews using excavators to dig the trench where the two new pipelines will be installed. All the work will take place behind the barricades of the work zone to ensure the safety of the public and crews while working. After the pipelines have been installed, crews will install temporary paving to cover the trench and continue to install pipeline. Every street where pipeline is installed will be fully repaved curb to curb and re-striped.

Throughout this work, crews will be using additional lighting on site, and noise associated with construction may be heard. Noise mitigation efforts have been implemented. Our team will continue to monitor the site to ensure these measures are enforced.
