- 19.5% reduction in motor vehicle theft has been recorded. Attributes the decrease to traffic signal cameras that alert PD when photo of stolen vehicle license plate is captured.
- Received data on call times for non-emergency call of 120 seconds and emergency call wait time of 7 seconds. The time of day in which that call is made can impact the officer response time.
