Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Upcoming Paving and Traffic Control Switch on Friars Road

Throughout next week, Oct. 13-17, crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project will be paving a portion of Friars Road and installing a new traffic control alignment. **As part of this new traffic control alignment, the ramp from Qualcomm Way onto westbound Friars Road will be closed for approximately 4-6 weeks. Please see the details below.**

- On Tuesday, Oct. 14, crews will pave approximately 600 feet of Friars Road, covering the trench for the newly-installed pipeline, starting just east of Russell Parkway. This paving operation will take one day.
- On Wednesday, Oct. 15, crews will install a new traffic control alignment between Russell Parkway and Qualcomm Way.
- **Northbound Russell Parkway from westbound Friars Road will be temporarily closed on Tuesday, Oct. 14 and Wednesday, Oct. 15 to accommodate this work. It will be fully reopened on Thursday Oct. 16.**
- **The ramp from Qualcomm Way onto westbound Friars Road will be closed starting Tuesday, Oct. 14. This ramp will remain closed for 4-6 weeks while crews install pipeline up to and past the ramp. Throughout this work, access will be maintained to Friars Road via Russell Parkway and Mission Center Road.**

The working hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Traffic control and the barriers around the work zone will remain in place around the clock, so after a shift is finished there will still be traffic control elements staying in the roadway.

During working hours, typical noise and dust are expected. All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone, and follow all posted signage.
