- Meeting Minutes: The Meeting Minutes from May 2025 were shared with all participants. A vote was held and approved 7 0 1.
- Officers Update: Officer Laurel-Torres attended today's meeting and gave a bit of shocking crimes report. Numbers below reflect stats collected dating back to May 1, 2025.
 - 27 reported stolen cars
 - 20 reported vehicles broken into
 - 7 reported drug overdoses
 - 66 vehicle collisions
 - 33 hit and runs
 - 6 calls for indecent exposure
 - 221 calls for disturbing the peace
- **Community Update:** District Representative, Moana Alo, from Senator Akila Weber Pierson's office, was present and introduced herself to the Planning Group.

Informational Item:

- Yasmeen Obeid, a Community Engagement Coordinator, gave a brief presentation and Q&A discussing the Commission on Police Practices. The presentation discussed the history, purpose, and goals of the Commission. General Purpose of the Commission includes:
 - Provide independent community oversight of the SDPD.
 - Evaluate complaints against the SDPD sworn personnel.

- Evaluate and review SDPD policies, practices, training, and protocols, and make recommendations for changes.
- Investigate officer-involved shootings, in-custody deaths, deaths resulting from interaction with police officer, and other significant incidents involving SDPD.
