Ocean Beach Planning Board,

The Transportation Committee requests board approval to pursue a placemaking application for a mural at the Bacon Street & West Point Loma Avenue roundabout. The City of San Diego's "mural toolkit" outlines site eligibility standards and a seventeen-step application process. The attached Exhibit A identifies the location (medians & sidewalks) which complies with site requirements. Materials used could be paint, "streetbond", or mosaic tile depending on budget, artist preference, or other determining factors.
