CITY HALL UPDATES

Beyer Park Update

We're excited to share the latest progress on the Beyer Park Development Project!

Phase I of the project is currently under construction and scheduled for completion in April 2026.

This phase includes core park infrastructure and a 5-year habitat restoration program that will continue through 2031.

Phase II will add sidewalks, park tables, benches, and a dog park.

By mid to late 2026 phase II will begin construction with phase I finishing late December.

Coral Gate Park Opening

The Coral Gate Neighborhood Park playground improvement project is near completion scheduled for a November 2025 opening!

The project includes both the design and construction of upgraded playground facilities aimed at enhancing recreational opportunities for the community.

It also includes a 90-day Plant Establishment Period, which is progressing well, with final turf results expected mid-October.

Brown Field Airport Update

The City of San Diego is making major strides in aviation infrastructure and economic development through nearly \$4 million in federal grants for Montgomery-Gibbs Executive and Brown Field.

- The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has awarded three grants to support the infrastructure upgrades
- \$2.8 million will fund design work for future rehabilitation of Montgomery-Gibbs Executive Airport's secondary runway, taxiways, and terminal apron
- \$1+ million will reimburse design costs for the rehabilitation of Brown Field Airport's taxiways
- The federal grants will cover 95% of the design costs the rest will come from airport generated revenue and no City General Fund money will be used

These grants will kickstart essential design phases and support the long-term maintenance and safety of both airports. Brown Field is also undergoing a 20-year redevelopment project to bring \$1.5 billion in economic impact and create approximately 2,500 jobs.

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

City of San Diego Eviction Prevention Program

The City of San Diego Eviction Prevention Program (EPP) helps renters with low income in the City of San Diego who are facing eviction for not paying their rent. EPP is operated by *Legal Aid Society of San Diego* through a contract with the *San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC)*.

Eligibility

- Reside at a City of San Diego address;
- Have household income at or below 80% of San Diego's Area Median Income (\$121,250/year for a family of four); and
- Have an obligation to pay rent.

Housing Instability Prevention Program

The *Housing Instability Prevention Program (HIPP)* helps pay rent and other housing-related expenses for families in the City of San Diego with low income, experiencing a housing crisis and at risk of homelessness. The *San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC)* operates HIPP for the City of San Diego with funding the *San Diego City Council* allocated specifically for the creation and continuation of this program.

How It Works

- SDHC provides enrolled households with \$250, \$500, \$750 or \$1,000 per month toward their rent, depending on the household's circumstances.
- HIPP also provides case management and assists with housing-related expenses, such as past-due rent and past-due utilities, depending on the household's need. These payments are made directly to the landlord or utility company.
- Enrolled households receive assistance for up to 24 months.

Who is Eligible?

- Must be a leaseholder and living in the City of San Diego
- Spending more than 40 percent of their gross income on housing in San Diego.
- After the rent subsidy is applied, the household cannot spend more than 80 percent of its income on rent.
- Experiencing a housing crisis, such as facing eviction, and at risk of homelessness.
- No alternative housing options. • Lack the money and support network to resolve their housing crisis.
- Household income is at or below 80 percent of San Diego's Area Median Income, currently \$121,250 per year for a family of four

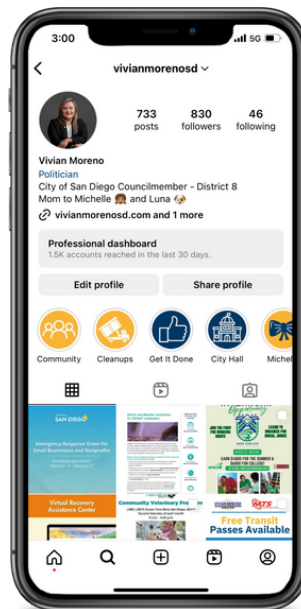
