ATTENTION NEW TRASH CONTAINERS ARE COMING



The City of San Diego Environmental Services Department is delivering new trash and recycling containers as part of a Citywide rollout. The container colors are changing to gray for trash and lighter blue for recycling.

What should I expect? You'll receive your container automatically. All old City trash containers will be removed. Delivery crews will leave new containers at your normal collection location (curbside or alley) with written instructions on the bins.

When will my bins arrive, and why do some properties have a different schedule? Use the "Container Delivery Lookup" below to find your date. Deliveries are based on your collection route and service day. With more than 225,000 households eligible for City-provided trash service, the delivery process is expected to continue over several months.

What bins will I get? You will receive what you ordered in the Portal. If you did not make service level selections, you will automatically receive only one 95-gallon trash and one 95-gallon recycling container per lot. If you do not already have one, you will get a 95-gallon green container. If old containers aren't removed, request pickup at sandiego.gov/GID.

I want to receive a different size/quantity, so how do I change my selection? You have 30 days after trash bin delivery to request an exchange of your new trash container(s) and to update your recycling container selections. Recycling containers will be delivered at a later date and cannot be swapped out later.
