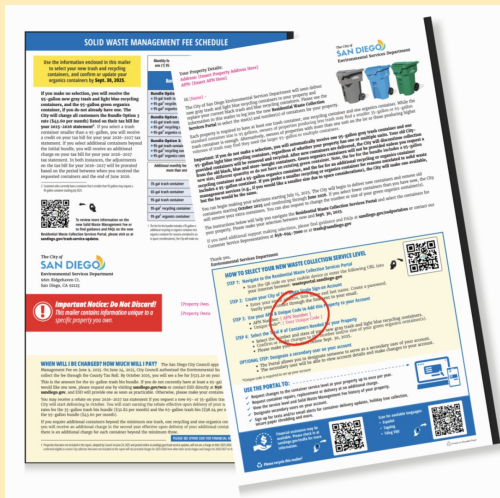

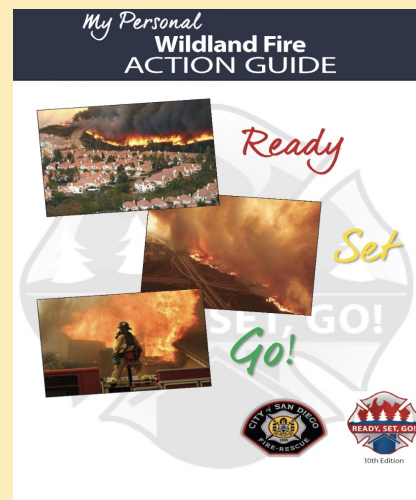


Trash Service Update

Have you received this letter from the City of San Diego in the mail? Property owners receiving City trash and recycling services are being asked to enroll in a new [customer portal](#) by **September 30, 2025**.

The City's Environmental Services Department is updating trash services, including transitioning eligible households to City-provided trash collection. Mailers have been sent with instructions and unique login details specific to each property.

Wildfire Season in San Diego

Here in San Diego, wildfire season is no longer a few months out of the year — it's every month. With an above-normal fire risk expected through October, the City is taking proactive steps to prepare, and I encourage all of us to do the same.

Let's all do our part to stay safe and keep our community protected.

The City of San Diego launched its first-ever Community Recreation Needs Assessment (CRNA), which will gather data on how to best provide public recreation services to you.

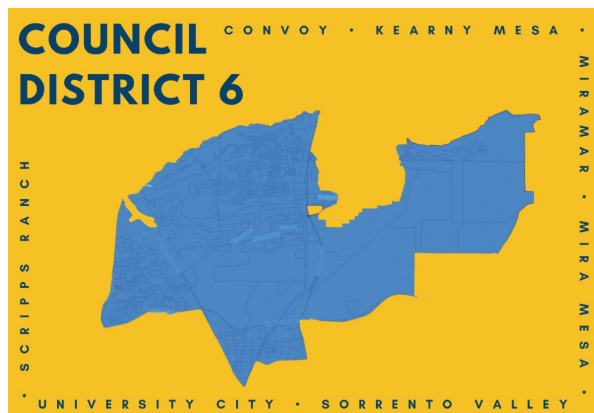
