## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Double Shifts at Nobel Drive and Genesee Avenue Intersection

Beginning Saturday, November 22nd, the City of San Diego's contractor will implement double shifts, including a night shift, to complete necessary work to re-open the Nobel Drive and Genesee Ave intersection to minimize traffic and community impacts for the holiday season.

Work is scheduled for Saturday morning through the evening of Wednesday, November 26, from 6:00 a.m. to 3:30 a.m., weather permitting. Night shifts are being implemented to complete pipeline installation through the intersection ahead of the Thanksgiving holiday.

Throughout this work, crews will be using additional lighting on site, and noise associated with construction may be heard. Earplugs are available onsite to residents upon request.

The traffic control shown on the maps below will remain in place 24 hours a day throughout the duration of the work. After work is completed in this segment, all travel lanes are expected to reopen. For safety reasons, please follow all posted signs including detours.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as safely and efficiently as possible. The University City community's patience and coordination are appreciated.

## What to Expect:

- Electronic message boards will be placed in advance of the work.
- Parking restrictions will be enforced; please avoid parking in areas with "no parking" signs. Vehicles in violation of these signs will be towed.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- Please anticipate traffic delays and construction noise.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035 and significantly reduce treated discharges from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant. Pure Water San Diego will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water and wastewater needs. San Diegans are getting dual value from this investment — reliable, sustainable drinking water and avoided wastewater costs. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities.
