#### **PARKS & RECREATION**

- Winter activities have started and signups are this coming Saturday.
  - Fall camp is next week, Thanksgiving week, and is a full waitlist.
  - Volleyball may get a banner.
  - Flag football has a few more weeks to play.
  - The Baker Elementary partnership has begun and there are 25 kids average per class.
  - Winter vent is 12/20/25 with Toys for Tots distribution (snow hill, petting zoo, jumper and churros)
  - Toys for Tots is closed and the deadline was 11/10/25. 80 families signed up representing 260 kids.
  - Proposed budget of \$8,000 for sports programming and \$14,500 for events in coming year. Projected ending balance of \$19,619 does not include the opportunity funds which can be as much as \$40,000 which must be spent. P&R requested recommendations and feedback on the budget.

### **New Business Items**

- Giving Hands has a drop-in center from Tuesday-Friday from 2 pm to 8 pm and Saturday from 10 am to 2 pm and trying to locate 100 turkeys. Signed up for 2,500 toys and wants to collaborate for toys and turkey giveaway. Want to start a community cleanup strikeforce to clean up elderly homes, light duty. They also have access to internships at \$100/mo for kids and \$10,000 scholarship funds available for SW College. Collaborated with local gangs (Bloods and Crips) and got a \$1,000,000 grant to stop violence in our community. Tuesday, 12/9, will be a Grand Opening Ceremony with media and CM Henry Foster. Also, looking for youth on probation, recently incarcerated people and resisting arrest cases.
- Dave Post announced the Youth Violence and Conflict Resolution Seminar – Saving Sarah's Daughters (dealing with childhood trauma). Changing trajectories.
- Brian Goodin provided an update on the park mural project. Hero Allen, who is the brother of Marcus Allen, is doing an awards banquet for 40-50 athletes, trying to coincide with this banquet. Also, trying to grow impact of the athletes that came from here as giving back to the community. Also, wants to increase media and outreach presence of our community (might have upcoming opportunities).
