These winter celebrations are planned at multiple recreation centers and parks and include food, entertainment, snow days, crafts, jumpers, cookies with Santa and more.

Events kick off this weekend during <u>December Nights</u> as dancers from <u>San Diego Civic Dance Arts</u> (SDCDA) <u>take the stage</u> on Friday, Dec. 5, and Saturday, Dec. 6, at the interior courtyard of the Casa del Prado Building in Balboa Park. SDCDA will present festive dance performances, magical lights, hot drinks, pastries and free photos with Santa.

While at December Nights, visitors are also encouraged to stop by the Botanical Building for the <u>annual holiday decoration and poinsettia display</u>, featuring over 500 poinsettia plants. Admission to both the SDCDA dance performances and the Botanical Building is free. Holiday decorations and the Botanical Building poinsettia display will be open for public viewing through Tuesday, Dec. 30.
