Police Investigating Suspicious Death of Infant Found in Mission Bay Restroom

San Diego — The San Diego Police Department (SDPD) is investigating a suspicious death after an infant was found inside a portable restroom at Dana Landing/Sunset Point in Mission Bay.

At about 1:27 p.m., SDPD received a 9-1-1 call from an employee conducting routine waste removal from a portable restroom at 1600 W. Mission Bay Dr. after the employee discovered an infant boy's body inside the restroom.

San Diego Fire-Rescue, San Diego Lifeguards, and the San Diego Police Department responded to the scene. The infant's death was pronounced a short time later by paramedics.

SDPD's Homicide Unit was notified of the suspicious circumstances and a pediatric death investigation was initiated.

The identity of the infant and his parents remain unknown at this time.
