SDPD Arrests Four in Connection to Murder of Linda Vista Man

San Diego — The San Diego Police Department (SDPD) has arrested four individuals for the murder of a man in Linda Vista in October.

On October 18, at 3:46 a.m., San Diego Police received a call of an injured and unresponsive adult man on the 6800 block of Osler St. Upon arriving, officers located 59-year-old Ruben Rimorin on the sidewalk suffering from trauma to his upper body. San Diego Fire-Rescue paramedics rendered aid, but unfortunately, Rimorin died of his injuries.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate. Preliminary information revealed that a group of men confronted the victim in the park area of the Linda Vista Recreation Center. A confrontation ensued, and the group physically beat the victim. The suspect group was described as Hispanic males in their 20s to 30s.

On December 10, 2025, San Diego Police Homicide Investigators, along with uniformed officers from the Special Operations Unit, arrested the following suspects in San Diego: 26-year-old Juan Lopez, 21-year-old Franklin Tuell, 20-year-old Brian Reyes, and 21-year-old Juan Alavez. The four suspects were booked into San Diego County jail for the murder of Ruben Rimorin.

This investigation was assisted by the use of SDPD's Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) system. Of the 35 homicides in San Diego in 2024, ALPR technology aided in one-third of them and helped lead to six apprehensions.
