## AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND

THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION TO AMEND ARTICLE 43 OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING RELATED TO CORPORATE APPAREL FOR PURE WATER AND SECURITY REPRESENTATIVE CLASSIFICATION SERIES IN THE PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

The City of San Diego (City) and the San Diego Municipal Employees Association (MEA) enter into this Agreement under the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act (MMBA) and San Diego City Council Policy 300-06 to amend the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) approved by Resolution R-314970 (June 12, 2023). The City and the MEA are collectively referred to as the "Parties."

Pure Water Operations Division employees currently do not receive corporate apparel. This amendment will ensure that all Pure Water Operations Division employees (Pure Water Treatment Superintendent, Senior Pure Water Plant Operations Supervisor, and Pure Water Plant Operations Supervisor) maintain a professional appearance that is consistent with other Public Utilities Department (PUD) operations employees.

The Security Representative classification series (Security Officer, Security Representative I, and Security Representative II) was created on July 1, 2018 to distinguish from the Safety Representative classification series (Safety Officer, Safety Representative I, and Safety Representative II). The Security Representative classification series performs vastly different tasks and requires different skillsets. To support the Security Representative classification series to perform their duties, including security and emergency planning, and regulatory compliance under the Department of Homeland Security's critical infrastructure protection program, PUD proposes to issue corporate apparel to employees in this classification series.

To promote employee visibility, safety, and professional representation, the Parties agree to amend Article 43 to provide corporate apparel for the Pure Water classification series and Security Representative classification series, effective upon Council approval of this tentative agreement.

Therefore, the Parties agree to the following:

- The Parties have satisfied all obligations under the MMBA, Council Policy 300-06, and other
  applicable law and regulations to meet and confer in good faith on the subject of this
  Agreement.
- 2. Article 43 of the MOU will be amended as follows:
  - a. Section M(8) will be amended to read:
    - 8. Employees in PUD **Pure Water Operations Division**, Water System Operations Division and Water Construction and Maintenance Division will be provided laundry service in those situations where home laundry of garments would present a health risk due to the nature of chemicals and/or materials encountered on the job.
  - b. Section M(10) will be amended to read:
    - 10. The following classifications shall be included in the Corporate Apparel Program:

- c. Section M(13) will be amended to read:
  - 13. Employees in the designated classifications in the **Pure Water Operations**Division, Water System Operations Division and Water Construction and
    Maintenance Division shall receive ten shirts and ten pairs of pants. Color options
    for shirts shall be light blue, navy blue, white, and khaki. Additional colors may be
    provided as an option at Management's discretion. Color options for pants shall be
    khaki, navy blue and denim.
- d. New section M(14) will be added as follows:
  - 14. Security Officer, Security Representative I, and Security Representative II in PUD shall receive ten pairs of pants, ten shirts (polo, tee, or button-up oxford) short or long sleeve, and one jacket (Chill Chaser). Color options for pants shall be tan, black or navy blue for dress slacks and black or blue for denim. Color options for shirts shall be tan, black, navy blue, or white.
- e. To reflect the addition of the new Article 43(M)(14), the existing subsections Article 43(M)(14) through Article 43(M)(21) will be renumbered sequentially as Article 43(M)(15) through Article 43(M)(22).
- This agreement is not binding on the Parties unless it is approved by a two-thirds vote of the City Council, in accordance with section 11.2.
