

Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Night Work Expected Nov. 30 through Dec. 9

Crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project will shift to nighttime work hours starting on Sunday, November 30 in order to install pipeline across the Friars Road and Qualcomm Way intersection. This work is taking place at night to allow crews to work safely within the intersection.

Night work on Friars Road:

- Night work hours will be between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- No work is expected to occur on Saturday, December 6.
- Please be advised that these are estimates, and the work schedule may change.
- After work in the intersection is completed, crews will return to daytime work hours.

During working hours, typical noise and dust are expected. All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone, and follow all posted signage.
