Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Crews Will Begin Installing Pipeline Westbound on Friars Road

Crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project recently began installing traffic control to accommodate pipeline installation on Friars Road between Russell Park Way and Frazee Road.

During the week of December 29, crews will perform initial saw cutting work to prepare the roadway for excavation. **Additionally, crews will be removing a portion of vegetation and select trees within the public right of way along Friars Road in order to accommodate pipeline installation. Before the Project concludes, the contractor will restore the impacted area with new vegetation and trees.**

The area highlighted in orange below the is approximate limit of where vegetation clearing and pipeline installation will take place.



Pipeline installation work is expected to start during the week of January 5, near the Russell Park Way and Friars Road intersection, moving west on Friars Road. Work will take place during daytime hours. The current project schedule estimates that this phase of pipeline work, between Russell Park Way and Frazee Road, will take approximately 60 days to complete.

During working hours, typical noise and dust are expected. All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone, and follow all posted signage.
