pies, and fresh produce today as part of a collaboration between Councilmember Raul Campillo, San Diego Carpenters Local 619, the San Diego Police Officers Association and Bayside Community Center. The distribution will run while supplies last. This event is intended to serve many of the people that already access food and resources through Bayside Community Center each week.
