


Pure Water San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines & Tunnels Project Update

- Three tunnels at SR-52, Rose Canyon (Genesee Avenue), and I-805 –2,322 linear feet of tunnel complete
- Pipeline installation – 40,894 linear feet of pipeline installed
- Recently completed and ongoing work:
 - *Ongoing work along Nobel Drive*
 - *Completed tunneling at I-805!*
 - *Continued work at Genesee Avenue and SR-52*






Current Work Sites

- Crews finishing curb and gutter replacement
- K-rail removed from southbound lanes
- Traffic control will remain in northbound lanes until pipeline connection is made between tested pipe segments
- Marian Bear Park reopening expected early 2026

- **Morena South and Middle Alignment has moved onto Genesee Avenue.**
- **Crews will install two underground pipelines that will connect to the Morena Pipelines Northern Alignment**
- **Work hours are 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday**
- **Southbound lanes will continue to be closed to vehicle traffic for 2-3 weeks.**
- **Once complete, the southbound lanes will reopen, and the northbound lanes will close for 3 weeks.**





Nobel & Genesee Intersection

- **Work hours:**
 - ***Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.***
 - ***Saturday from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.***
- **24-hour traffic control set-up**
- **Northbound through traffic on Genesee Avenue will be detoured right onto eastbound Nobel Drive and northbound on Towne Centre Drive and La Jolla Village Drive to Genesee Avenue.**
- **Eastbound traffic along Nobel Drive will not be able to cross the intersection and will be required to turn left or right onto Genesee Avenue.**




Nobel & Genesee Intersection


Upcoming Work

- **Medians on Nobel Drive will be restored, including replanting of trees**
- **White Crepe Myrtle instead of Eucalyptus**

Paving and Bike Lanes

- **Work to be completed before paving:**

- 48" and 30" pipeline installation
- Installation of pipeline appurtenances
- Both pipelines must pass testing
- ADA curb ramp upgrades
- Additional concrete work
 - *Medians, sidewalk panels, cross gutters*

- **Final paving expected in 2026**
- **New bike lanes will be implemented after paving is complete**
- **Traffic lanes will not be reduced**
- **Street parking will be impacted in select areas**
- **More details to come early 2026**
- **Planned bike lane segments:**
 - *Along Genesee Avenue between Appleton St. and Nobel Dr.*
 - *Along Nobel Dr. between Genesee Ave through Town Center Dr.*
 - *Along Town Center Dr. between Nobel Drive and Executive Dr.*

Full Alignment: What You Can Expect

- Work will occur during daytime with occasional night work
- **Monday-Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., occasional Saturday work, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.**
- K-rail for safety of public and workers
- **Access for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles will be maintained where possible; some delays expected**
- Construction equipment and material staging will be in work zone and will move along with construction
- Traffic control throughout project area
- Trails remain open at all times
- Impacts such as noise, dust, bright lights and construction vehicle traffic during work hours
