ITEM 1: 8383 LA SCENIC DRIVE NORTH – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1117322

Plan Area: La Jolla

Site Development Permit to demolish a 2,740-square-foot, one-story single-dwelling unit with a 560-square-foot detached garage and construct a new 6,292-square-foot single-dwelling unit with a 505-square-foot attached two-car garage, a 799-square-foot detached accessory dwelling unit, and a 227-square-foot junior accessory dwelling unit for a total of 7,823 square feet located at 8383 La Jolla Scenic Drive North. The 0.59-acre site is in the La Jolla Shores Planned District Single-Family [LJSPD-SF] Zone, the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, the Parking Impact Overlay Zone, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (MCAS Miramar Review Area 2), Transit Priority Area, Sustainable Development Area, and Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone within the La Jolla Community Plan Area.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Sections 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction), 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures), and 15332 (In-Fill Development Projects) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

ITEM 2: ELLEN BROWNING SCRIPPS PARK SIDEWALK WIDENING – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1135809

Plan Area: La Jolla

Coastal Development Permit and Site Development Permit to remove approximately 450 linear feet of an existing 5-foot-wide concrete sidewalk and

install a 10-foot-wide concrete sidewalk as a replacement. The scope includes minor grading as needed and relocation of existing irrigation. The 5.29-acre project site is located at Ellen Browning Scripps Park, 1160 Coast Boulevard within the OP1-1 (Open Space – Park) zone; the Coastal Overlay Zone (Appealable, First Public Roadway), the Parking Impact Overlay Zone, a Parking Standards Transit Priority Area, a Transit Priority Area, the Sensitive Coastal Overlay Zone and the La Jolla Park Historic District (HRB# 915) within the La Jolla Community Plan. This development is within the Coastal Overlay Zone (appealable), and the application was filed on May 15, 2025.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

ITEM 3: 7991 PROSPECT PLACE – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1067494

Plan Area: La Jolla

Coastal Development Permit an amendment to Coastal Development Permit No. 1743872 to dismantle a one-story, 833-square-foot historically designated residence (HRB Site #1174) and reconstruct and rehabilitate the residence, porch, and stairs at its original location in accordance with the U.S. Secretary of Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation. The 0.126-acre site is located at 7991 Prospect Place in the RS-1-7 Zone (Residential-Single Unit), the Coastal Overlay Zone (Appealable Area), the First Public Roadway, the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, the Parking Impact Overlay Zone, the Transit Area Overlay Zone, the Transit Priority Area, and the Sensitive Coastal Overlay Zone (Coastal Bluff) within the La Jolla Community Plan area.

The project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15331 (Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

ITEM 4: 3241 MISSION VILLAGE DRIVE – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1129604

Plan Area: Serra Mesa

Tentative Map Waiver for the creation of 25 residential condominiums for sale, and one commercial condominium consisting of 35 for-rent apartment units, including three affordable dwelling units at very low-income level, a waiver to the requirements to underground existing off-site overhead utilities, and associated site improvements. The 1.72-acre project site is currently under construction and is located at 3241 Mission Village Drive in the CO-1-2 (Commercial Office) zone, Complete Communities Mobility Choices Mobility Zone 4, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (ALUCOZ) Review Area 1 for Montgomery Field, and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Part 77 Noticing Area for Montgomery Field within the Serra Mesa Community Plan.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15332 (In-fill Development).

TO SPEAK TO A PARTICULAR ITEM DURING PUBLIC COMMENT:

In Person for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: Please fill out a speaker slip located at the entrance to the meeting. Indicate the item you wish to speak on as well as other requested information. Then submit it to City staff.

Via Virtual Platform for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: When the Hearing Officer introduces the item (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the “Raise Your Hand” button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by dialing *9 on your phone. You will be taken in the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item. When the Hearing Officer indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial *6 on your phone.

Please Note: Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes. The queue will close when the last virtual speaker finishes speaking or five minutes after in-person testimony ends, whichever happens first. *Those participating virtually may NOT cede time to others participating in person or virtually.*

HOW TO PROVIDE WRITTEN COMMENTS:

Comments must be the business day prior for it to be distributed to Hearing Officer. All webform comments are limited to 500 words but may include attachments. Written Materials: Instead of submitting materials as an attachment to the [webform](#), you may submit via U.S. Mail to the Hearing Officer at 7650 Mission Valley Road, MS DSD 1A, San Diego, CA 92108. Materials submitted via U.S. Mail must be received the business day prior for it to be distributed to the Hearing Officer.

Late-Arriving Materials:

Pursuant to the Brown Act, California Government Code Section 54957.5(b), late-arriving documents related to the Hearing Officer meeting agenda items which are distributed to the legislative body prior to and during the meeting are available for public review at the Development Services Department Building, 7650 Mission Valley Road, 1st Floor, San Diego, CA 92108. This relates to those documents received after the agenda is publicly noticed and during the 72 hours prior to the start of the meeting.
