NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

PROJECT NAME: As-needed Design Environmental Services for 20100 San Pasqual Road Storm Drain Replacement

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: San Pasqual

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 5

LOCATION: The proposed project would be located within City of San Diego public right-of-way and on City-owned land along San Pasqual Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Mayoral action to allow award of an environmental design services contract for the 20100 San Pasqual Road Storm Drain Replacement project. The proposed project would repair approximately 900 linear feet (0.17 mile) of existing asphalt-paved ditch, replace approximately 40 linear feet (0.01 mile) of existing 18-inch corrugated metal pipe (CMP) storm drain with a dual 30-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) culvert, install a new headwall, endwall, and riprap energy dissipator. The proposed consultant services include, but are not limited to, biological resources surveys and reporting; data collection; cultural resources surveys and reporting; archaeological testing; environmental permit support; environmental analysis; and jurisdictional delineation.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: This activity is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies).

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review which determined that the project meets the statutory exemption criteria set forth in CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies) for approval of the design consultant services contract, which includes subsurface soil testing activities for archaeological testing and jurisdictional delineation.

Applications to appeal CEQA determinations made by staff to the City Council must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk within five (5) days from the date of the posting of this Notice, December 16, 2025. Appeal procedures are described in Information Bulletin 505 (<https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/dsdib505.pdf>). Appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or in person as follows:

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked within five (5) business days of the date the appeal is filed.

Deposit the fully completed appeal application (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building – Public Information Counter (Open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday excluding City-approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer. Please include the project name on the memo line of the check/money order. This Drop-Off Box is checked daily, and payments are processed the following business day.
