COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- **San Diego Parks Foundation** - Martha shared that the Foundation continues to do great work, such as field renovations, tree planting, and a recently held community event. She also mentioned a new partnership with San Diego FC. The citywide flag football event will be held at Robb Field on December 13, 2025, with hundreds of children and families in attendance and participating. The event will run from early morning through the afternoon, and cheerleading will also be added this year. Martha also shared that in March, the citywide basketball event will be held at City College. There will be a wheelchair basketball exhibition game to encourage adaptive sports participation. She explained that teams from recreation centers across the City of San Diego come together in an elimination-style format, making it a standout community event. Keith asked if there are fees to participate in the events. Adolfo and Martha clarified that there are no special event fees beyond standard recreation center registration costs. Fees vary by recreation center

and are typically minimal, covering items such as uniforms, trophies, and banquets, with many programs offered at little or no cost.

- **Point Loma/Cabrillo Tennis Club**- tennis is club is status quo, doing quite well, user friendly increased the cleaning of the courts.
- **Point Loma Summer Concerts**- Dates are set for the summer concerts. Little League asked to not place the portable toilets on the field, portable toilets are please outside of the fencing and worked better than previous years. Martha recommended to add the backstop fencing work to the FY27 maintenance portion of the budget.

101. General Area Report

Adolfo shared that the debris from the 619 building has been removed. There is no current timeline of when the walls that are currently standing, the plan is to get them down and put a portable building for Cabrillo Staff to relocate on site at NTC Park. Martha asked what happened to the Bike Coalition and the renovating of the 191 building, Adolfo stated that they have run out of funding. Martha suggested a calculation of the temporary structure cost and the cost to refurbish the 191 building. Mary harder asked if we can clean up the brush along canon and in the park along the residential fencing. Adolfo will provide update on the historical wall at Canon Pocket Park.
