In accordance with Public Utilities Code section 132354.7 and Public Contract Code sections 2600-2602, PCL Construction, Inc. (the "Prime Contractor") certifies that all the workers performing work in an apprenticesable occupation utilized on the project known as Metro Biosolids (Pure Water) (the "Project") during the monthly reporting period are either skilled journeypersons or apprentices in an apprenticeship program approved by the Chief of the Division of Apprenticeship Standards of the California Department of Industrial Relations (the "Chief").

In addition, the Prime Contractor certifies that it has met the requirements of Public Contract Code 2601(d), subject to certain exceptions set forth therein, that the required percentage of the skilled journeypersons or skilled journeyperson hours employed to perform work on the Project by the Prime Contractor and all subcontractors are graduates of an apprenticeship program for the applicable apprenticesable occupation.

A graduate of an apprenticeship program means either of the following:

- (1) An individual that has been issued a certificate of completion under the authority of the California Apprenticeship Council for completing an apprenticeship program approved by the Chief pursuant to Section 3075 of the Labor Code, or
- (2) An individual that has completed an apprenticeship program located outside California and approved for federal purposes pursuant to the apprenticeship regulations adopted by the federal Secretary of Labor.
