Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Upcoming Night Work at Friars Rd. and Frazee Rd. Intersection

Starting on Sunday night, Jan. 25, crews on the Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project will begin night work to install pipeline within the Friars Road and Frazee Road intersection.

Night work hours will be between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning. This phase of work is expected to take approximately one week. During working hours, the Friars Rd. and Frazee Rd. intersection will be closed to traffic and detours will be in place. During non-working hours, the intersection will be fully opened to traffic. Please follow all posted signage when traveling through the intersection during working hours.

All work will take place behind safety barricades set up in the roadway, please allow extra time when traveling through the work zone. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will install temporary paving to cover the trench and continue to install pipeline. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving. In addition to installing new pipelines, crews will also be replacing select curb ramps along the project alignment to bring them up to current ADA standards.
