## CODE OF CONDUCT

The City of San Diego ("City") takes great pride in providing the highest quality service to customers and visitors to our golf facilities. The City of San Diego Code of Conduct ("Code of Conduct") was created to ensure a safe, welcoming, and friendly place for the golfing public and visitors to enjoy. To achieve this, all visitors to City of San Diego golf facilities are expected to adhere to the following:

1. Comply with all City laws, policies, and regulations.
2. Adhere to instructions given by staff.
3. Uphold an environment of integrity, respect, and good sportsmanship.
4. Refrain from behavior that could be perceived as threatening, belittling, or verbally abusive to fellow golfers, visitors, and/or staff.
5. Foster a discrimination and harassment-free environment.
6. Observe proper etiquette on the golf course, in the clubhouse, and in the golf shop.
7. Show respect and dignity to fellow golfers, visitors, and staff.
8. Refrain from modifying and/or damaging City property, including facilities, course amenities, signage, equipment, and turf.
9. Report real or perceived safety hazards to staff.

***Anyone found to be in violation of the City of San Diego Golfer Code of Conduct may have one or all the following occur:***

- Revocation of Resident ID Card.
- Removal from the facility.
- Suspension of playing privileges.
