Item 11: City Planning Department Fiscal Year 2026 Work Program (Information)

Andrew Martin (Staff Liaison) presented an overview of the following initiatives included in the City Planning Department's Fiscal Year 2026 Work Program that support Climate Action Plan implementation:

Item 12: Climate Advisory Board 2026 Work Plan (Discussion)

Kelly Lyndon (Vice-Chair) led a discussion of the Work Plan survey results, Board priorities, and a suggested schedule to develop the 2026 work plan.

Public Comment

Sydney Tesch (member of the public): Asked that the Board meet in each City Council District and rotate Districts, that the Board align its Work Plan with the City's fiscal year, and that efforts be made to align the Climate Advisory Board and Resiliency Advisory Board on coastal and marine issues.

Paul Meccurio (member of the public): Asked that the Board prioritize Climate Action Plan action BE-1.2a, focusing on building electrification in all new buildings, and that the Board examine building code and nitrogen oxides rules.

Maya Prunty (member of the public): Asked that urban canyon restoration be made a Board priority and include clear metrics and equity criteria for canyon projects, especially in Communities of Concern. Urban canyon management should include community-identified actions and community-guided priorities.

Sophie Tesluk (member of the public): Asked the Board to develop and define a specific goal to protect and restore blue carbon ecosystems as an important carbon sink, including salt marshes, kelp forests, and eelgrass meadows.

Tess Noone (online member of the public): Asked that the Board include a focus on coastal salt marsh ecosystems. While DeAnza Natural Plan is a good model, the 2024

Climate Action Plan Annual Report did not mention clear next steps in wetland restoration as an effective solution to climate change.

Item 13: End-of-Year Roundtable (Discussion)

Tanisha-Jean Martin (Chair) led a discussion of the survey sent to Board members by the Work Plan ad-hoc committee, highlighting the major issues and areas of focus that were identified.
