Area Manager Report: Claudia Apodaca, Mira Mesa Community:

- Wangenheim will be shut down for aerification, fertilization, and rest from June 30 to August 11.
- Safety bases were installed at the softball fields at Wangenheim.

Center Director Report: Erin Holbech, Lopez Ridge Neighborhood Park:

- Field allocations for Fall are coming up and we will be doing a joint allocation with Hourglass for the Mira Mesa Area.
