Speakers will be called in the order hands are raised. Each person may speak only once on a particular item. When staff calls on you, unmute your device by following the on-screen prompt or by dialing \*6 on your phone.

**Public Comment on Matters Not on the Agenda:** You may address the PAC on any matter not listed on today's agenda. Please complete and submit a speaker form. California's open meeting laws do not allow the PAC to discuss or take any action on the matter at today's meeting. At its discretion, the PAC may add the item to a future agenda or refer it to staff or a committee. Individual comments are limited to three minutes per speaker. If a large

number of people wish to speak on the same item, the Chair may limit the time for each speaker or for the item.
