- A. **CALL TO ORDER AND ATTENDANCE** – by Chair VMarshall at 6:22pm.
- B. **APPROVAL OF THE MAY MINUTES** – Motion to approve by JBroadwin, seconded by RSubramanian unanimously approved.
- C. **STATE SENATOR JONES REPORT** – Kyle Hermann
 - a. Absent.
- D. **COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 REPORT** – Joaquin Quintero
 - a. Last meeting, has moved to La Jolla, new representative is Sandy Mach; Council voted on 2026 proposed budget, Mayor vetoed budget, Council now has 5 days to work through details; ADU reforms in the pipeline; SMach – (Transportation Dept rep not available) walk of sidewalk areas in community – concerns about trip hazard areas – due to budget and staffing challenges, it will take some time to resolve these issues, RSubramanian – shared issue with repairs requested through Get It Done® – sidewalks merely patched with asphalt ramps – JQuintero – please be sure to include location and an image of area being reported when using Get It Done®, homeowner responsible for repairing sidewalks that have been damaged by their trees, etc.
- E. **OFFICE OF THE MAYOR** – Fatima Maciel
 - a. Parking reform package – targeting on-street parking only – doing dynamic pricing at these meters that will change based on time of day – events, etc., rates forthcoming, increasing pricing for valet parking permits as well; amendments to community parking districts concerning what types of projects they can commence with; Budget FY2026 – Mayor vetoed budget – a few specific items: 1.CPPS – want equal services throughout the City; 2. Bringing back position of CEO; City repaired 1,200 sidewalks YTD, full repairs to sidewalks will take some time – will continue to do temporary repairs (asphalt), BFagan – broached concern with having waited 10-years for repairs to sidewalks throughout Torrey Hills – how much longer is ‘some time’?
