NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit – Mission Hills 5k Run/ Walk

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Uptown

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

LOCATION: 1521 Washington Place/surrounding roadways in Mission Hills, Pioneer Park

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a 5K run/walk that would include the routes, music, games, fun fair activities, and the temporary use of an inflatable arch, generator, fencing and/or barriers, portable restrooms, recycling/trash containers, tables, chairs, and amplified sound that would occur in Mission Hills on March 21, 2026. Pioneer Park would be the location for the Finish Line Fun Fair. Noise associated with the event activities and setup/dismantling would occur from 8 AM on March 20, 2026, until 9 AM on March 22, 2026. Set-up would occur from 8 AM until 9 AM on March 20, 2026. The event would occur from 7 AM until 1 PM on March 21, 2026. The dismantling would occur from 8 AM until 9 AM on March 22, 2026.

There would be road and parking closures associated with this event. See 5K route map, road and parking closures attached.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311 (Accessory Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no

significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal.

Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building— Public Information Counter (Open 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday excluding City approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.

Mission Hills 5K

1. Start at Washington Place in Front of Grant School Teacher Parking Lot. Cross St -Ingalls St. Head west on Washington Place.
2. Turn right onto Randolph St.
3. Turn right onto Fort Stockton Dr
4. Turn left onto Hawk St
5. Turn left onto W Lewis St
6. Continue on W Lewis St and take a slight right onto Fort Stockton Dr (runners stay on right side since reusing street)
7. At the end of Fort Stockton Dr, take a left onto Arista St
8. Turn left onto Hickory St. (Stay on left side of street)
9. Turn right onto Fort Stockton Dr (runners stay on right side of street since reusing street)
10. Take a slight left to follow W Lewis St (stay on right side of street)
11. Turn right onto Hawk St
12. Turn right onto Fort Stockton Dr
13. Turn left onto Randolph St
14. Turn right onto Wahsington Place. Finish line On Washington Place (Pioneer Park on left, shortly after tennis courts).
