City of San Diego, Council District 8: Gerardo Ramirez</b>  Gerardo Ramirez – proposed budget – reminder 5.6 million budget for this fiscal year with 2% cut. Library programming, teen center hours, parks and rec. parks hour, 8 park rangers full time proposed all north of interstate 8, except for 1 position. Mayor wants to move forward with 1,000 bed shelter 15-million-dollar initial commitment from budget. We can recovery all the cuts if we use this money. 13.5 million recovered from initial cuts. 780k for SD access for all, 6m continued shelter, 7m homeless, 250k no shots filed, 420 staffing. We still have cuts we need to work on. Whole state is in deficit. Final budgets approved in Mid-June (June 17). Bin at Boston and 30<sup>th</sup> from 9-12pm. Next one June 15. Unwanted items disposal. Continue to push city re light maintenance. City will be in district 1 and 2 for maintenance. We want them to come to district 8.</p> <p>Hector.
